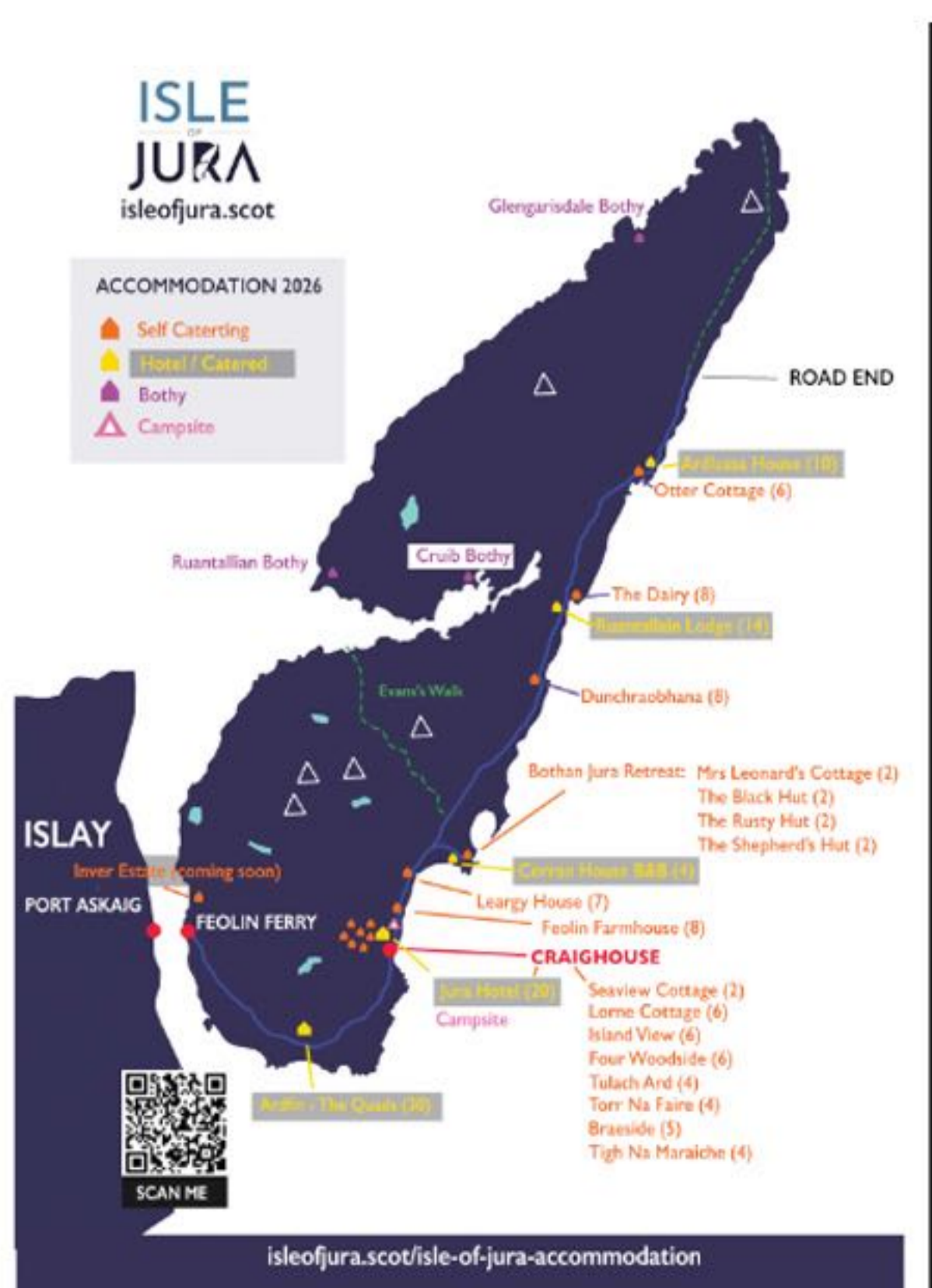


# Jura Tourism Pack

- Calmac RET Scheme not available on this sailing.
- Concession/Disabled cards to be displayed/shown to crew.
- This is a turn up and go service, you do not need to book a specific sailing unless the timetable is marked A or B.
- The crew are present for your safety. Follow their guidance and instructions at all times.

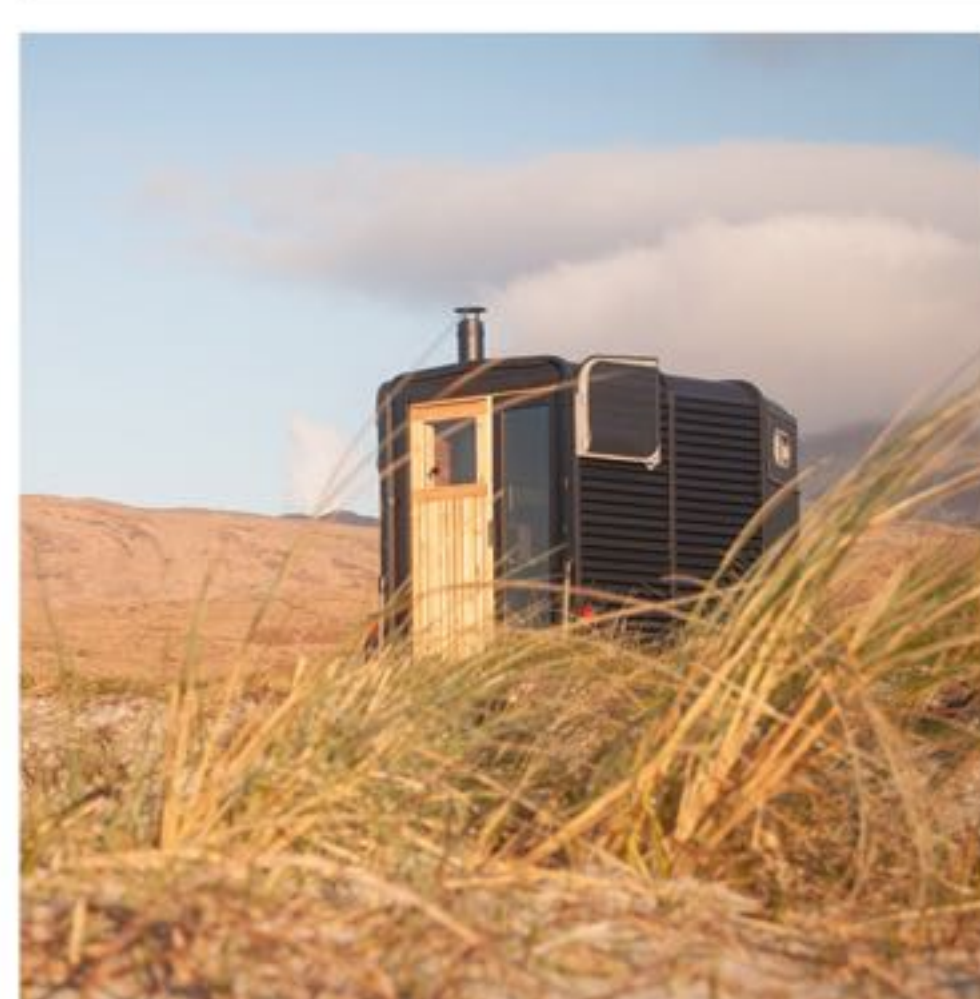

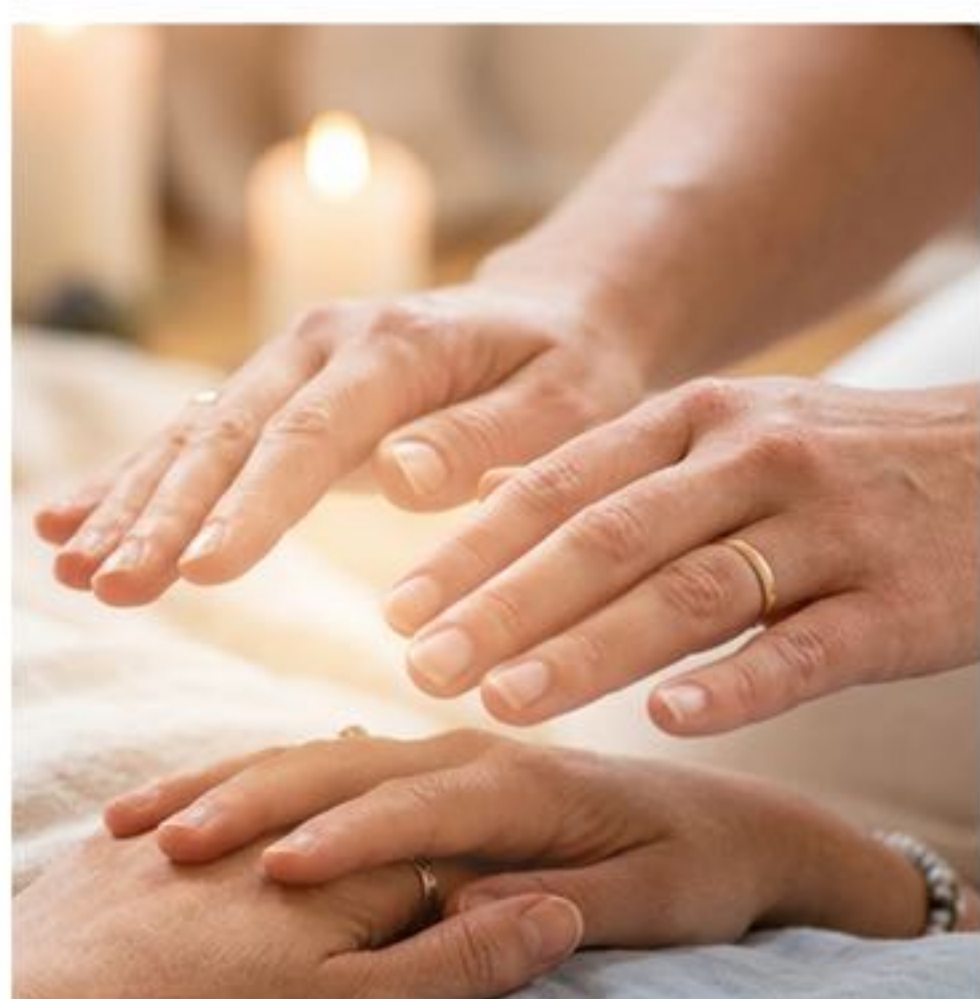

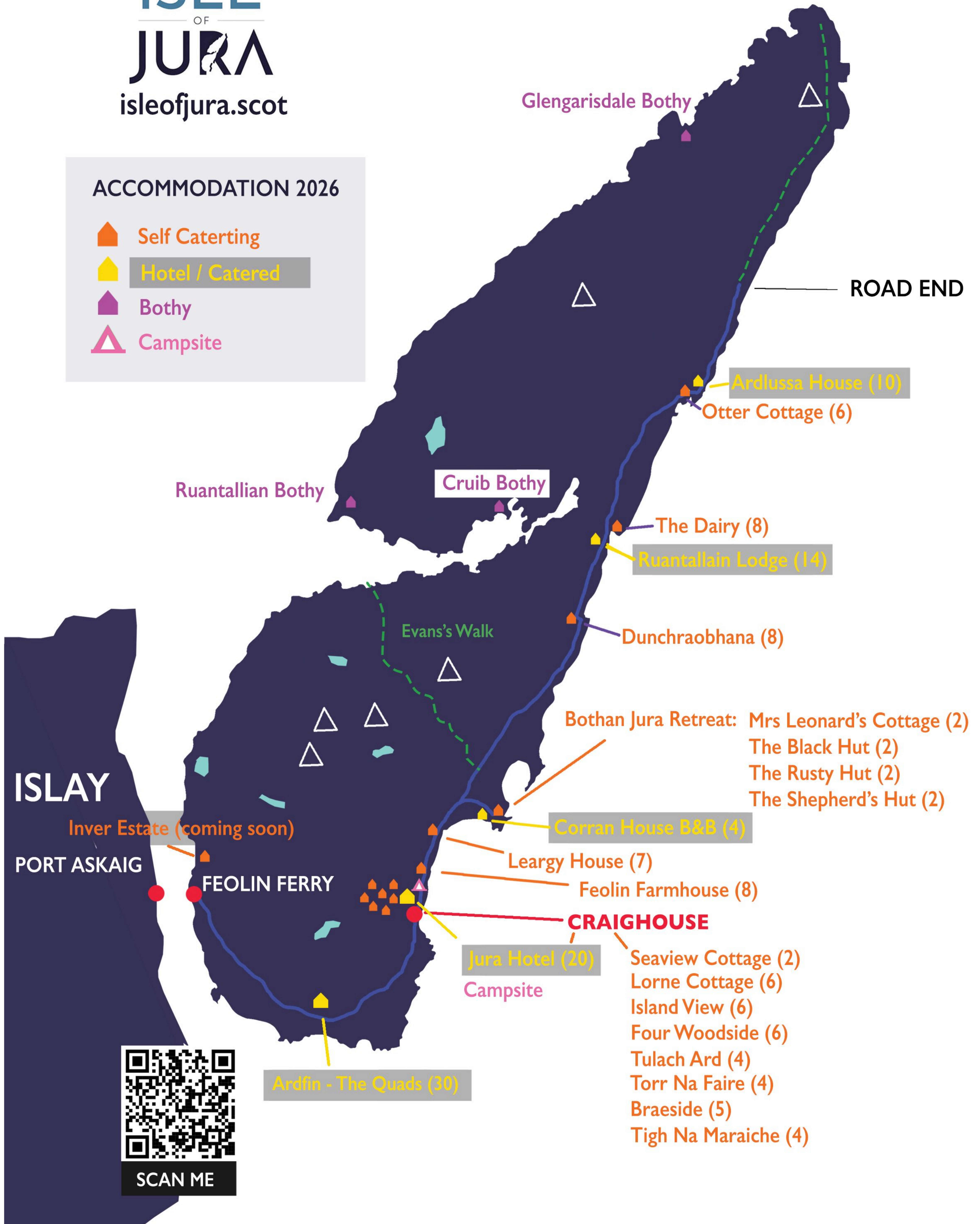

# ISLE of JURA



There's not much to do on Jura.  
That's exactly why people seek it out.

As spring arrives here on Jura there is excitement as the Sound of Jura fills with dolphins, the boggy routes up to the Paps dry up (ha we lie, they NEVER dry out!) and the island's 258 residents emerge blinking into longer days, already planning the season's calendar of events that has kept this community alive for generations.

One road. One shop. One pub. More red deer than people. And yet visitors who make the effort to reach Jura, and it does take effort, almost universally say it's one of the most memorable places they've ever been. Our visitor survey is giving us real insight into why people come. "Jura is a different world - rugged, wild, uncompromising." "It gave a deep feeling of magic in your soul."

What you get here is the real thing, a functioning island community that welcomes visitors in rather than just serving them. The community calendar is vibrant and packed. The Jura Bake Off. Amateur Dramatics (JamDram). Jura Fell Race. The Dog Show. The Regatta. Jura Sports at Ardlussa. Jura Music Festival. Spontaneous ceilidhs and traditional music



sessions in the village hall, with a new generation of young Diurachs keeping the tunes alive. These aren't tourist events, they're the traditions that keep island life alive and we invite visitors to get involved, to join in, to dance, sing and laugh with us.

Spring and summer bring the island to life. Wildlife returns in abundance - sea eagles, dolphins, otters, and the ever-present red deer. The Paps offer one of Scotland's most challenging and rewarding hill walks. Corran Sands and the west coast beaches are yours alone. The weekly craft fair returns to the village hall, showcasing local makers and artists. Jura is also becoming a destination for wellbeing - new for 2026, a mobile wood-fired wild sauna will be popping up and down the length of Jura, alongside forest bathing, yoga, and reiki, with the sea always close by for wild swimming and paddleboarding.

The Jura Passenger Ferry runs directly from Tayvallich on the Scottish mainland to Craighouse - no need to go via Islay if you're not bringing a car. With extra trips to Gigha this season, it's the most scenic route to the island for foot passengers and cyclists.

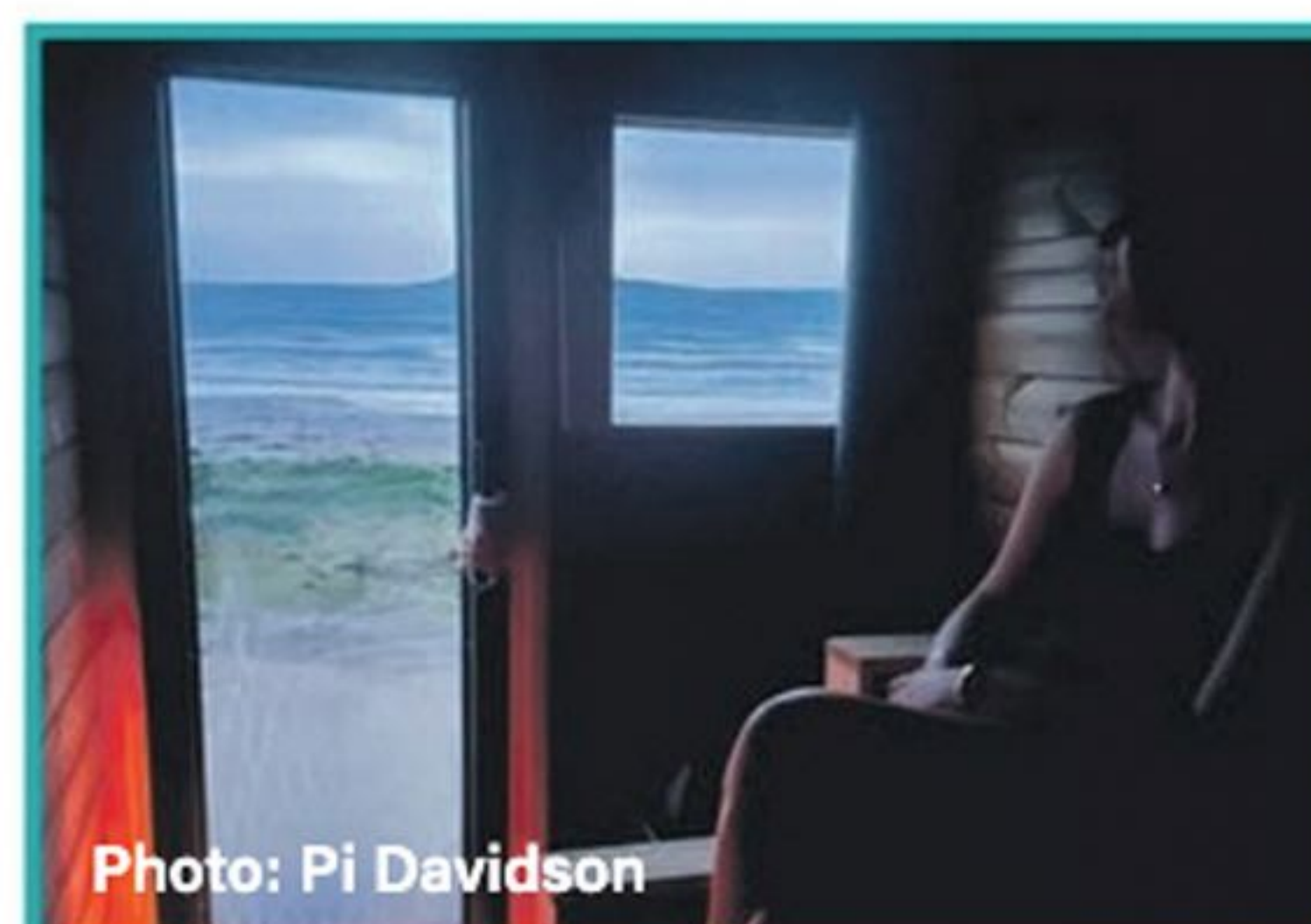

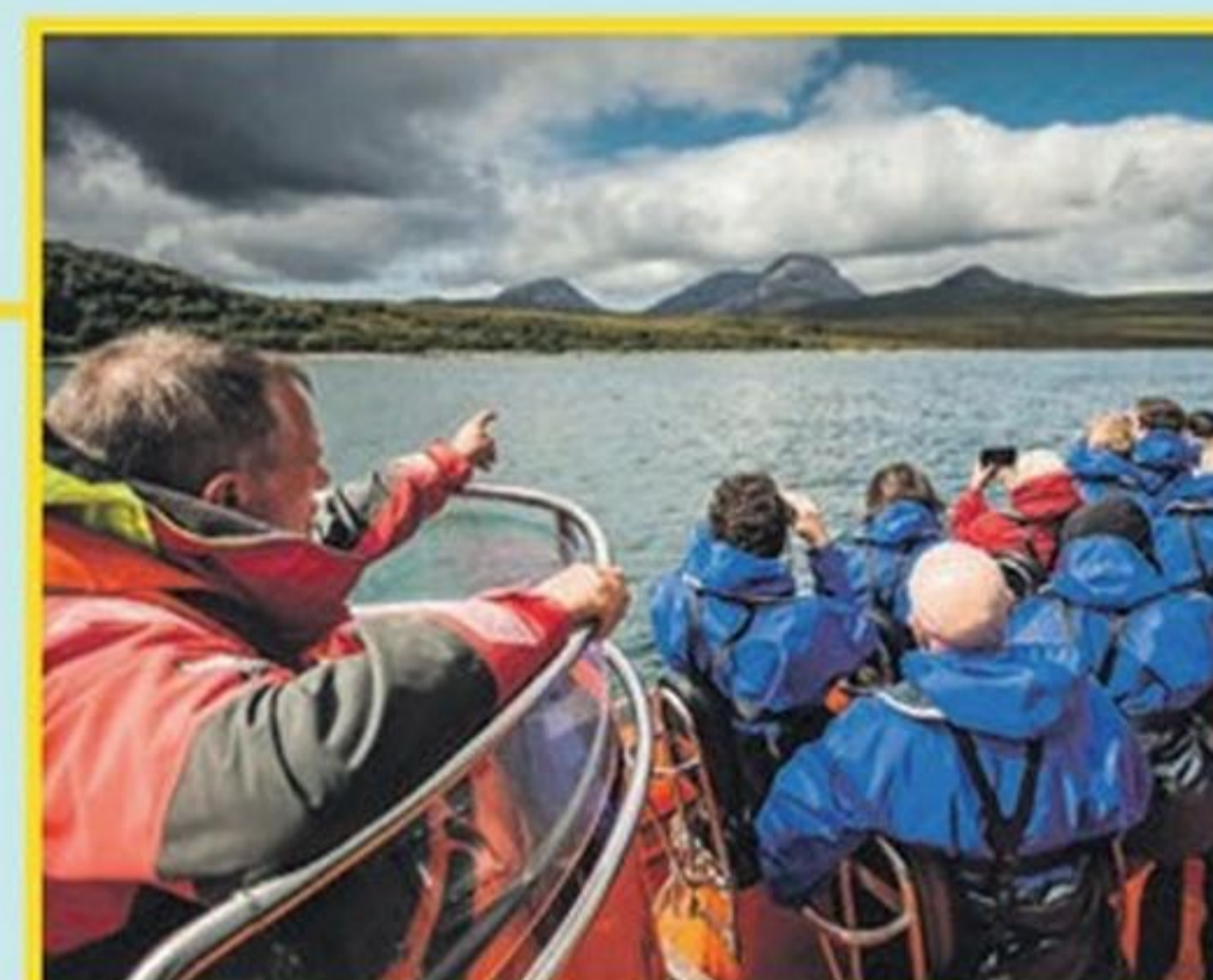
## Wellness & the Wild Sauna

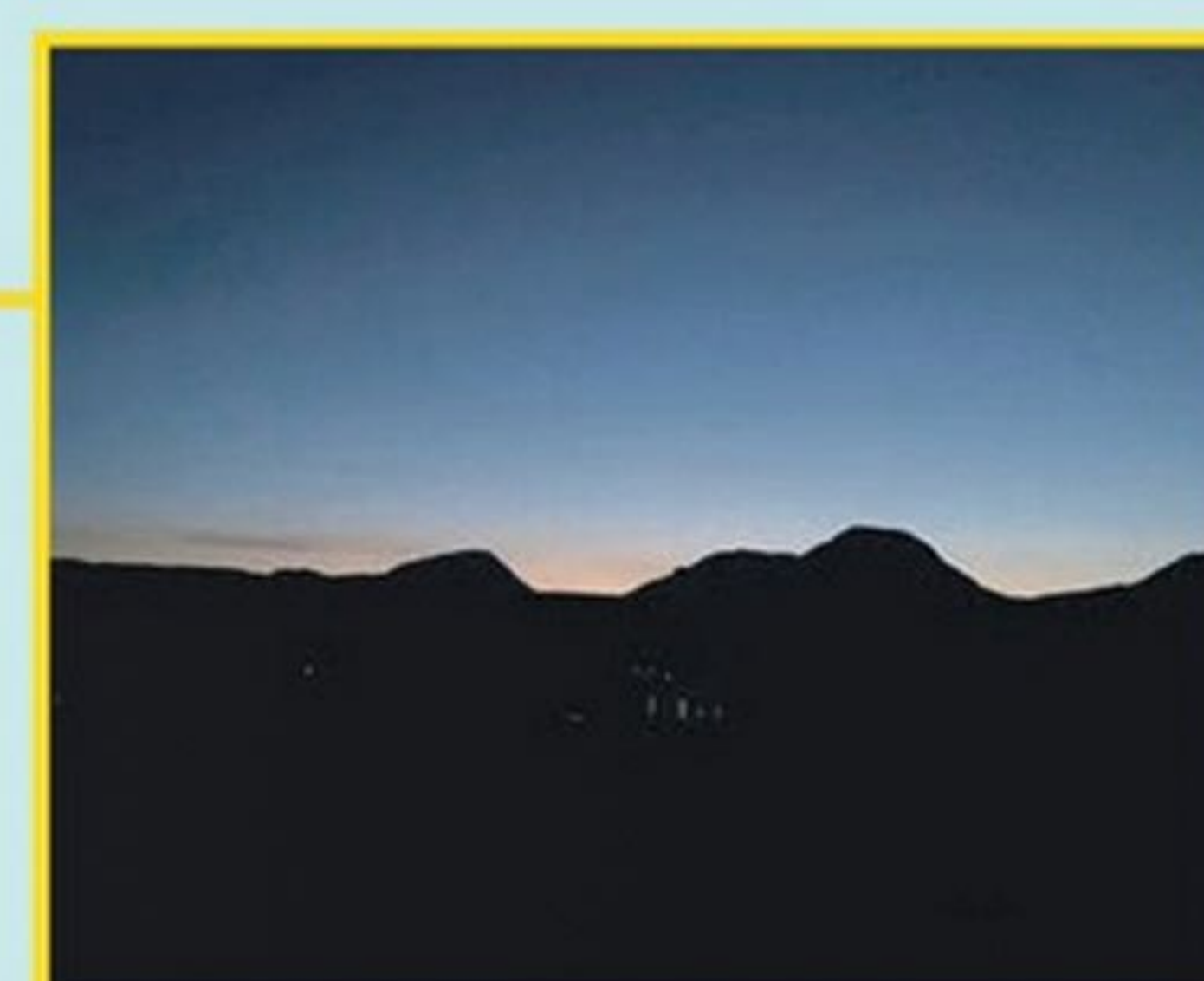
## Climb the Paps of Jura
